Even before Sir Stamford Raffles established a free port of Singapore, archaeological digs suggest that the island was an important hub for traders from both Asia and Europe. Sir Stamford was very forward thinking. He banned slavery and set up a special area for people of Indian origin and another for people of Chinese origin. Now Chinese are 75% of the population with Malays the second largest ethnic group and Indians the third. However, the Chinese are from a diverse origin and the Chinese community, as a whole, speaks mutually incomprehensible dialects. The Indian group is just as diverse and this has resulted in there being four official languages - English, Mandarin, Malay and Tamil.

Singapore is the busiest port in the world with over 600 shipping lines sending super tankers, container ships and passenger liners to share the busy waters with fishing vessels and wooden lighters. It has a huge, very modern, container port and many oil refineries. It has become one of the most important financial centres in Asia, with more than 130 banks. Cape Town could do well to emulate Singapore. London may even need to do the same after **Brexit**
