However, they must be extra strong, as the boxes are very heavy, and be very fit to be able to negotiate terrain where everything has been destroyed.</p> <p>Individuals and organisations may purchase boxes by donating R10 500 per box. Each box will be numbered and can be followed, through the internet, to where it is being used.</p> <p>Sharon introduced, and Bev thanked Biffy for a most interesting talk.</p>
